Take a photo.</p>	<p><u>Activity #3</u> Complete three IXLs (A.4, A.5, A.6) for 7th grade or (F.4, F.5, F.6) for 8th grade to 80% OR work on Front Row/ST Math for 30 minutes.</p>	<p><u>Activity #4</u> Label 15 items in Spanish and take a picture of your labels. (8th grade only)</p>
<p><u>Activity #5</u> Measure your heart rate before an activity (such as jogging for 5 minutes). Complete the activity and measure your heart rate again. What was the activity? What caused the change in your heart rate?</p>	<p><u>Activity #6</u> Collect at least five points of change over time (i.e. snowfall, temperature, etc).
