

# Reading Interventions:

## *Elementary Selected Level (Tier 2)*

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In the fall of 2011, a study done for the Department of Public Instruction asked elementary schools to identify reading intervention programs and practices used at the selected level (Tier 2). Eighty-three Wisconsin elementary schools completed the survey. A list of the most commonly used interventions as well as links to more information is provided below. (Survey results did not include which school grade-levels were associated with which interventions. Also, no specific school was associated with a specific intervention as a result of its survey response. *Note that the Wisconsin Rtl Center is reporting these data for the benefit of Wisconsin schools and does not endorse any specific reading interventions.*)
